The purpose of this letter is to provide USC families with an update in regards to Governor Walz's Emergency Executive Order 20-02 which closes schools on Wednesday, March 18th through Friday, March 27th. In addition:

- School will be closed on Monday, March 16th for students. Friday, March 13th is now the official end of 3rd quarter and teachers will be working on 3rd quarter grades.
- We will have a two hour late start for students on Tuesday, March 17th. Students will be asked to clean out lockers. Some materials for potential distance learning activities will be sent home.
- USC staff will be planning for distance learning activities between Wednesday, March 18th and Friday, March 27th. USC will not require students to take part in any learning activities during this time.

There are many items USC administration and staff must address in the coming days. We wanted to get the plan for the next two days so families can plan for tomorrow. The administrative team will be working on the most time-sensitive issues first and communicate those items out as quickly as possible. Thank you for your patience in this ever-evolving situation.
